GENERAL FRENCH

All our courses are based on the **Common European Framework** for Languages that defines the skills acquired at each learning level.

The courses are given by native French teachers, qualified to teach French as a Foreign Language.

General Public: adults, teenagers, children. A reduced number limited to 12 students per class.

A completion certificate including the teacher's remarks and comments is delivered to the student. Knowledge evaluation: Each session ends with an evaluation that will allow the student to evaluate his knowledge of the language.

Personalized follow-up : A remediation follow-up is suggested to the student in case he is facing difficulties to assimilate the information studied in class.

CONVERSATION COURSES

Starting from level A2, students will have oral expression courses, and will have the opportunity to use their acquired knowledge in speaking. These courses will take place whether in the morning or in the evening, according to the number of students.

THEMATIC COURSES

These courses consist of punctual workshops that take place once per month. They tackle different themes and are based on the interaction with resourced persons. An announcement will be made 15 days in advance on our website.

FRENCH FOR SPECIFIC PURPOSES

The French Institute in Kuwait offers French courses for specific purposes according to your professional occupation or personal needs. These courses are not designed for complete beginners. An assessment of your French proficiency level is required in order for us to be able to set up a custom-made program according to your personal needs and requirements.

These courses are given in groups (a minimum of 6 students) or in private (1 or 2 students), and end with an exam leading to a certification from the Chamber of Commerce and Industry in Paris (CCIP) or from the International Center for Studies in Education (CIEP).

PRIVATE COURSES

The main priority of the French Institute in Kuwait is to meet the specific needs and requirements of its students. Therefore, the private courses have been especially designed to address this concern. The private courses are also given by highly qualified native French teachers.

THE FRENCH INSTITUTE IN KUWAIT: AN EXAMS AND PLACEMENT TESTS CENTER

The French Institute is an exams center accredited by the Chamber of Commerce and Industry in Paris (CCIP) and from the International Center for Studies in Education (CIEP).

The General French courses allow students to pass the DELF (French Language Studies Diploma) and DALF (Advanced French Language Diploma) exams. No specific prior preparation is necessary because our courses are already based on the **Common European Framework for Languages progression.**

Students who wish to assess their level for university applications or for immigration to Canada, may pass the appropriate tests provided by the French Institute in Kuwait. They may pass the TCF (French Knowledge Test), the TCF-Quebec (French Knowledge Test for Quebec) delivered by the International Center for Studies in Education (CIEP), the E-TEF (French Evaluation Test in electronic format), and the E-TEF-Quebec delivered by the Chamber of Commerce and Industry in Paris. A level certification is delivered to them by the CCIP or the CIEP 3 to 4 weeks after the test. C'est Super
